



European Lighting Expert Re-Registration

Preface

In order to be allowed to continue to use the title "European Lighting Expert", each certified ELE must prove, five years after registration, that their professional understanding is based on the current state of the art and the latest scientific findings. For this purpose, they have the opportunity to renew their proof of competence in the years after certification through a continuing education management with a point system.

Points System

A total of 60 points must be earned in 5 years, ideally 12 points per year.

A maximum of 24 points can be credited in one year. Thus, it is possible to achieve the necessary re-registration points in a minimum of 2.5 years.

Final points (minimum 12 points) to achieve must be accumulated in the last year before re-registration to ensure that the ELE is up to date with the latest technology and scientific knowledge.

Points can be earned through various accomplishments and measures to be taken, such as:

- Participation in further education
- Professional publications
- Lectures, teaching
- Realized projects

Events for re-registration must have a clearly technical component, must be registered with the re-registration application and must be accepted by the national organizations.

Projects, professional publications, professional lectures and teaching, etc. must be submitted to and evaluated and accepted by the national organizations.

The point system is based on the assumption that one point is attainable for 2 teaching units (approx. 2x45min.) for participation in subject-relevant further education.

For a realized project, depending on the scope, up to a maximum of 12 points can be credited, whereby a maximum of half of the required points (i.e. a maximum of 30 points) are possible through projects.

For publications or lecture activities, depending on the length and content of the publication or number of lecture hours, corresponding points can be credited, whereby max. half of the required points (i.e. max. 30 points) are possible.

If no documents for re-registration are submitted to ELEA, or the country representative, one month after the required re-registration date, the name will be removed from the ELE register and the registration as an ELE will be withdrawn. The examination must be successfully completed again for re-registration.

If ELEA, or the national association, does not receive documentation for re-registration one month after the required re-registration date, the name will be removed from the ELE registry

and registration as an ELE will be revoked. The examination must be successfully completed again for re-registration.

Evidence of continuing education must be provided by submitting certificates of attendance or similar documents.

The publications, lecture activities as well as the projects are to be submitted according to the template with the required enclosures.

*) Project: This refers to lighting projects (lighting design, lighting control, lighting concept, luminaire refurbishment, etc.) and should include several service phases (e.g. concept, detailed design, implementation, commissioning, etc.).

Costs

For re-registration there is a total cost of 125€ per specialty.
